First Aid Courses

As advised earlier the Reporoa Valley Schools Cluster is organising two First Aid Courses this year .

- 1) At the Rerewhakaaitu Settlers Hall on **2nd April**. This 8 hour course is being provided by Life Care Consultants at a cost of \$180 (incl) with a refresher available for half the day at \$100 per person.
- 2) At a venue to be confirmed (probably Reporoa) on **28/29th July**. This 2 day comprehensive course is being provided by Red Cross at a cost of \$120 for the comprehensive course and \$70 for the one day refresher course.

- 2) If insufficient registrations are received the courses will be cancelled.
